**ORDINANCE No. 02-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN,  
COUNTY OF SUSSEX, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
AMENDING CHAPTER 161 REGARDING PARKING  
COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 161 of the Franklin Borough Code is amended as follows:

**SECTION I**

Subsection 161-32D(5) is hereby replaced as follows:

(5) Commercial trailers, tractors and mechanized equipment in residential zones. Not more than one commercial vehicle not greater than 19,500 pounds gross vehicle weight shall be kept, placed or stored in any residence zone. Said vehicle shall be owned, leased or regularly used by a resident of the premises. This provision shall not be deemed to limit the use of a commercial vehicle in connection with farming operations.

**SECTION II**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION III**

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.


**SECTION IV**
