

**ORDINANCE NO. 15-2020**

**ORDINANCE OF THE FRANKLIN BOROUGH COUNCIL  
AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN  
CHAPTER 56, REGARDING NEPOTISM”**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey the Franklin Borough Code entitled, “Personnel Policies” be amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Chapter 56 is modified to add subsection §56-1S as follows:


§56-1S. No person who is related to a Borough elected office holder, department head, the Borough Clerk, Tax Assessor, Chief Financial Officer, Tax Collector or a person employed on a full-time basis shall be employed by the Borough, except for employment in a part-time seasonal or per diem position. A relation for the purpose of this section is defined as brother, sister, husband, wife, life partner, son, daughter, ward, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, sister in-law, father, mother, father-in-law, mother in-law, grandmother, grandfather, grandson and granddaughter.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.


**SECTION 3.** If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.




