BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG-COUNTY OF SUSSEX ORDINANCE 06-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG, COUNTY OF SUSSEX AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 30 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "LAND DEVELOPMENT" RELATING TO THE BOROUGH'S BC, BOROUGH CENTER DISTRICT ZONE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Ogdensburg Land Use Board ("Board") has reviewed Chapter 30 of the Borough Code entitled "Land Development" and determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to consider certain amendments to same including the BC, Borough Center District Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Ogdensburg ("Borough") has received and reviewed the amendments proposed by the Board which relate to automotive repair services, LED and free-standing signs, and parking waiver decision making authority in the BC Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Borough agrees with the recommendations by the Board and now seeks to amend and supplement Chapter 30 to incorporate said recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 30 of the Code of the Borough of Ogdensburg entitled "Land Development" is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 30, Section 30-201 of the Borough Code entitled "Definitions" is hereby amended to add the following definition:

Chapter 30 Land Development

§ 30-201. Definitions.

AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR SERVICES

Establishments engaged in the repair of vehicles, including the repair of mechanical systems and/or the repair of exterior and interior body damage, as limited by the restrictions of the zone in which the establishment is located.

SECTION 2. Chapter 30, Section 30-411 entitled "BC Borough Center District" shall be amended by deleting Section 30-411(A)(6) in its entirety and replacing same as follows:

A. Permitted Principal Uses.

6. Professional office and/or commercial service, i.e. bank, barber shop, beauty salon, studio, tailor shop, clinic real estate office, auto repair services, and other business and governmental offices.

SECTION 3. Chapter 30, Section 30-411 entitled "BC Borough Center District" shall be amended by deleting Section 30-411 (H)(4) and Section 30-411 (H)(6) in their entirety and replacing same as follows:

H. Signs.

- 4. Any permitted exterior sign may be illuminated but shall not have any flashing, pulsating, or continuously moving parts. Neon signs are prohibited for exterior display. All exterior signs shall be professionally painted and lettered and may not contain any fluorescent or "day-glo" based paint or materials. LED signs are permitted but the borough prohibits LED signs with any movement activity of the sign itself, not a flashing sign or moving sign.
- 6. Only one free-standing or sandwich-type sign is permitted per building, regardless of multiple use of the building. Such signs shall not exceed 2x3 square feet in display and only out during business hours. Such signs must be placed at least 10 feet from the curb line and not interfere with pedestrian traffic or obstruct the view of vehicular traffic.

SECTION 4. Chapter 30, Section 30-411 entitled "BC Borough Center District" shall be amended by deleting Section 30-411(I)(3) in its entirety and replacing same as follows:

I. Required Parking.

3. The above parking requirements may be waived by the Zoning Officer if the site under consideration contains a pre-existing structure and has little or no undeveloped land area available to meet these parking requirements.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or a portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective after second reading and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, the DEWA offers recreational opportunities such as hiking, walking, bicycling, fishing, hunting, swimming, camping, canoeing, boating, cross country skiing, bird watching, horseback riding, sightseeing, and special events; cultural resources, infrastructural facilities, national resources, and rare, threatened and endangered species of plants, fish, mammals, reptiles and amphibians; and

WHEREAS, Sandyston Township is over 70% state and federal land, along with thousands of acres of farmland, and the residents of Sandyston Township enjoy the recreational opportunities as well as cultural and natural resources of this open space and local businesses benefit from the tourism brought by Stokes State Forest, State of New Jersey, Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Fish & Wildlife and DEWA bring to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Sandyston is aware of the initial proposal in 2022 and a revised proposal 2023 by the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance seeking to change the designation of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area and Middle Delaware National Scenic and Recreational River to the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance offers no insight, plan or benefit to the residents of Sandyston Township in the proposed change in designation; namely the environmental, economic and agricultural impact to the DEWA and to the residents and local businesses of Sandyston Township and Sussex County; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance offers no insight or information on how the rights of public land and private property owners will be safeguarded and protected against eminent domain to acquire and public lands, namely, Stokes State Forest, High Point State Park and State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Fish & Wildlife lands as well as acquisition of private property; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance will reduce tax revenue realized by Sandyston Township and surrounding municipalities, negatively impact enrollment of local school districts, and negatively impact our local economy by reducing access to recreational activities enjoyed by residents and visitors to Sandyston Township and Sussex County; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance offers no information on the plan to facilitate this change; the implementation of fee collection and location of collection stations; and how funding will be provided for this proposed National Park; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance offers no information on the plan to compensate local volunteer first responders (Fire and EMS) on the inevitable increase in emergency calls and response, wear and tear on vehicles and equipment and devastation to these organizations both financially and in membership and will adversely impact and affect the safety, health and welfare of the residents of Sandyston Township and Sussex County; and

WHEREAS, the proposal by the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance offers no insight or plan on funding and maintenance of infrastructure and vegetation management; changes agricultural leasing which will economically impact farmers who depend on crops to hold livestock over the winter months and farming for cash crops; causes agricultural fields to fallow and which will encourage invasive species such as Russian Olive to thrive allows Forest to Field Conversion which will leave approximately 58,000 acres in the proposed preserve open to timber degradation, land clearing, soil erosion, resource extraction, mineral, gas and oil exploration, and wildfires.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Township Committee of the Township of Sandyston firmly opposes the proposal of the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance, or any other organization, seeking to change the designation of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area to a National Park and Preserve as this proposal offers no benefit to the residents of Sandyston Township and Sussex County.

emergency calls and response, wear and tear on vehicles and equipment and devastation to these organizations both financially and in membership and will adversely impact and affect the safety, health and welfare of the residents of Sandyston Township and Sussex County

WHEREAS, the proposal by the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance offers no insight or plan on funding and maintenance of infrastructure and vegetation management; changes agricultural leasing which will economically impact farmers who depend on crops to hold livestock over the winter months and farming for cash crops; causes agricultural fields to fallow and which will encourage invasive species such as Russian Olive to thrive allows Forest to Field Conversion which will leave approximately 58,000 acres in the proposed preserve open to timber degradation, land clearing, soil erosion resource extraction, mineral, gas and oil exploration, and wildfires.

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Sandyston firmly opposes the proposal of the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance, or any other organization, seeking to change the designation of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area to a National Park and Preserve as this proposal offers no benefit to the residents of Sandyston Township and Sussex County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Sandyston does hereby support New Jersey Assembly Resolution AR133 and New Jersey Senate Resolution SR93 opposing all proposals to change the designation of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area and Middle Delaware National Scenic and Recreational River to the Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve.

Parker Space; New Jersey State Senator Douglas Steinhardt; New Jersey Assemblyman Michael Inganamort; New Jersey Assemblywoman Dawn Fantasia; New Jersey Assemblyman John DiMaio; NJ and PA State Assembly and State Senate members; Sussex County Board of County Commissioners; all municipalities of Sussex County; National Park Service, Charles Sams, Director; National Park Service Northeast Region, Gay Vietzke, Regional Director; Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area, Doyle Sapp, Superintendent; Delaware River Basin Commission; Partnership for the Delaware Estuary; National Lands Trust; Warren County Board of County Commissioners; Kittatinny Regional High School Board of Education and Craig Hutcheson, Ph.D., Superintendent; Sandyston-Walpack Consolidated School Board of Education and Joseph Kraemer, Interim Superintendent; New Jersey League of Municipalities; Delaware River National Park and Lenape Preserve Alliance; New Jersey and Pennsylvania Chapters of the Sierra Club.
