RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTION ON BLOCK 1401 LOT 1

WHEREAS, The Department of Veteran Affairs determined that Ronald Breidenstein at 40 Washington Ave., Block 1401, Lot 1, had a service connected disability that was totally disabling.

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has received a Claim for property tax exemption on dwelling house of Disabled Veteran, which was approved by the Tax Assessor.

WHEREAS, as per N.J.S.A.54: 4-3.30et seq, Ronald Breidenstein is entitled to a tax exemption on the property located at 40 Washington Ave. from September 2nd, 2026, the date of application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Tax Collector is authorized to cancel taxes billed from September 2nd, 2026.
2. The Tax Collector is authorized to cancel partial 3rd quarter 2026 taxes in the amount of \$1,003.11 and the full 4th quarter of 2026 amount along with the full 1st and 2nd quarter amounts of 2027;
3. The cancellation of taxes from date of approval has created an overpayment in taxes, therefore the Tax Collector is authorized to refund Ronald Breidenstein in the amount of \$1,003.11.
4. This property will be marked as Exempt.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
