

**Resolution No. 2019-70**

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN MEMORIALIZING  
THE POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES FLEET MAINTENANCE AND  
REPLACEMENT PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council wants to establish a Police Department Fleet Maintenance and Replacement Plan to memorialize the current plan and guide future Councils;

**WHEREAS**, the police vehicles fall into two (2) categories:

Mainline Patrol Fleet  
Auxiliary Fleet

**WHEREAS**, the mainline patrol fleet will be comprised of five (5) fully outfitted patrol vehicles five (5) years old or less with 100,000 miles or less and vehicles in this fleet will have unit numbers in the 3100 series;


**WHEREAS**, the auxiliary fleet will be comprised of detective bureau and good condition former patrol vehicles and there will be four (4) vehicles included in this fleet with unit numbers in the 3190 series. One (1) vehicle will stay as a fully outfitted patrol vehicle. This vehicle will be considered the sixth vehicle of the mainline patrol fleet in case of breakdown;

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council starting in fiscal year 2020, has decided that any new police vehicles purchased will be Ford products with the interceptor package and a non-turbo engine. A five year, 100,000 mile warranty will be specified. New units will be kept for a period of five (5) years in mainline patrol service. Current 2019 vehicle fleet will be retired at the 100,000 mile mark and transferred to the auxiliary fleet;

**WHEREAS**, in fiscal year 2021 and subsequent years, any new police vehicles will be purchased every other year;

**NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey, that this Vehicle Maintenance and Replacement Plan is hereby adopted as a Resolution to guide the current and future Councils on the policy, which the Governing Body believes will be predictable for the Police Department and result in the Police Department having reliable vehicles to perform their essential functions.
